Sec. 8-4-1 General Provisions.

The purpose of this Chapter is to ensure effective collection of solid waste and to further ensure that solid waste collection and disposal does not interfere with the collection of recyclable material under Chapter 3 of this Title.

Sec. 8-4-2 Definitions.

For the purpose of this Chapter, the definitions provided in Section 8-3-8 shall apply.

Sec. 8-4-3 Applicability.

The requirements of this Chapter apply to occupants of single family residences and apartment complexes with no more than four (4) residential dwelling units.

Sec. 8-4-4 Solid Waste Disposal Requirements.

Except as otherwise provided by the Village Board or the Director of Public Works, solid waste containers shall be placed at or near the curb, alley or street edge for collection on days designated by the Village. All solid waste shall be placed in clear plastic bags or in a collection container that permits the hauler to determine visually that solid waste has been separated from recyclable material and avoids littering or blowing of the contents of the container.

Sec. 8-4-5 Enforcement

- (a) For the purpose of ascertaining compliance with the provisions of this Chapter, any authorized officer, employee or representative of the Village of Muscoda may inspect solid waste separated from recyclable materials, postconsumer waste intended for disposal, solid waste collection sites and facilities, collection vehicles, collection areas,

and any records relating to solid waste collection and disposal activities, which shall be kept confidential when necessary to protect proprietary information. No person may refuse access to any authorized officer, employee or authorized representative of the Village who requests access for the purpose of inspection and who presents appropriate credentials. No person may obstruct, hamper or interfere with such an inspection.

- (b) Any person who violates a provision of this Chapter may be issued a forfeiture citation by the Muscoda Police Department. The issuance of a citation shall not preclude proceeding under any other Title or law relating to the same or any other matter. Proceeding under any other Title or law relating to the same or any other matter shall not preclude the issuance of a citation under this Subsection.
- (c) Any person who violates a provision of this Chapter may be required to forfeit not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each violation.
